A Public Hearing is an opportunity for you to present information concerning a matter prior to a decision being made by the El Cajon City Council. An Agenda is prepared for the meeting and the Public Hearing items are considered in the sequence shown unless the order is changed by specific action of the City Council. The agenda may be viewed on the City's website: www.cityofelcajon.us, or may be picked up in the City Clerk's Office, after 4:00 p.m. on the Thursday before the meeting date. Copies of the agenda are also available at the meeting.

If you wish to speak at the meeting, please complete and give a Speaker's Card to the City Clerk. When the City Clerk calls your name, please come forward to the podium to be recognized by the Mayor, stating your name (address is optional). Remarks should be relevant to the subject and as brief as possible. A letter expressing your views may be submitted to the City Clerk's Office prior to the meeting for distribution to the City Council.

When testimony from the audience is completed, or it is determined by the City Council that testimony will not be helpful, the hearing is closed from further public input. The City Council may discuss the item and a motion is made to take specific action. An electronic voting system will simultaneously display the votes cast on a motion. A green light indicates a "YES" vote, a red light a "NO" vote, and a white light indicates "ABSTENTION." A motion for affirmative action requires three "YES" votes.
