

ORDINANCE NO. 4763

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 2.16.020 OF  
CHAPTER 2.16 AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 2.16.020  
OF CHAPTER 2.16 OF THE EL CAJON MUNICIPAL CODE  
ADJUSTING SALARIES OF COUNCILMEMBERS  
AND MAYOR EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005.

The CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL CAJON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2.16.020 of Chapter 2.16 of the El Cajon Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: A new Section 2.16.020 of Chapter 2.16 of the El Cajon Municipal Code is hereby added to read as follows:

**2.16.020. Salaries of councilmembers and mayor.**

With the exception of the mayor, each member of the council of the city shall receive, as salary, the sum of one thousand four hundred thirty-four dollars per month, as prescribed in Title 4 Division 3 of the Government Code of the state of California for cities over seventy-five thousand up to and including one hundred fifty thousand in population, which shall be effective January 1, 2005, in the same manner as the salaries are paid to other officers and employees of the city.

The mayor of the city shall receive, as salary, the sum of two thousand sixty-eight dollars per month, which shall be effective January 1, 2005, in accordance with the provisions applicable to members of the city council as hereinabove set forth.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall become effective thirty days following its passage and adoption.
